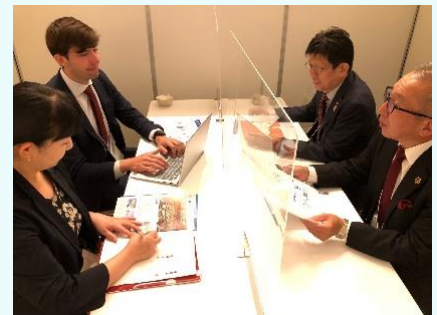

Why is Osaka “a town of pharmaceuticals”?

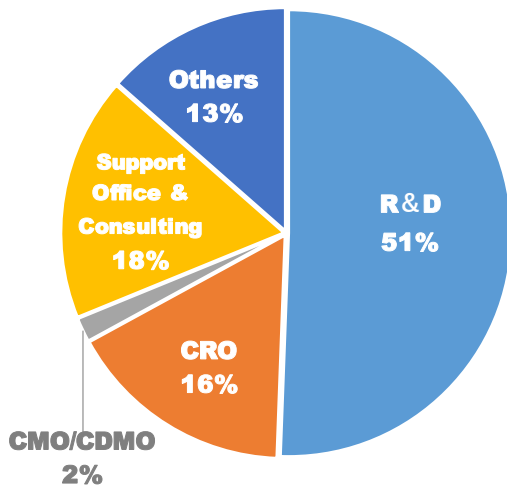
Osaka has been known as “a town of pharmaceuticals” for about 400 years. The history has its origin in the era of Samurai, when approx.120 official brokers in Osaka undertook role as quality inspectors and seller of herbal medicine nationwide. This authorization led to establishment of many manufacturing wholesalers and leading schools of medicine including western medicine, which become some of the most famous companies and universities today.

Not only its historical backgrounds, but also today’s local government policy have affected on the concentration of life science business and academia in Osaka. In “New strategy for revitalization and growth of Osaka” (2020) by Osaka Prefectural Government, health & medical industry is regarded as expected leading industry of post-covid-19 economy. Not only the government alone, but also with start-ups, Companies and research and educational institutions, Osaka is trying to create innovation in new health & medical industry.

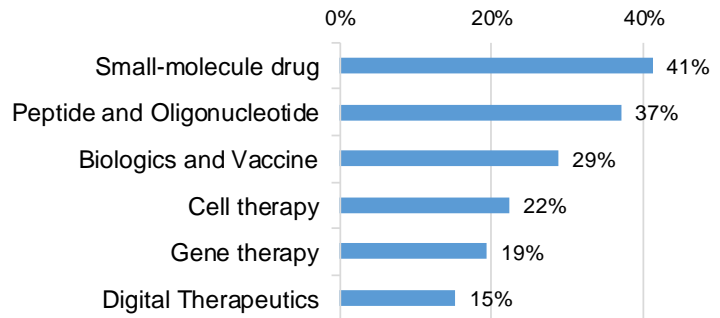

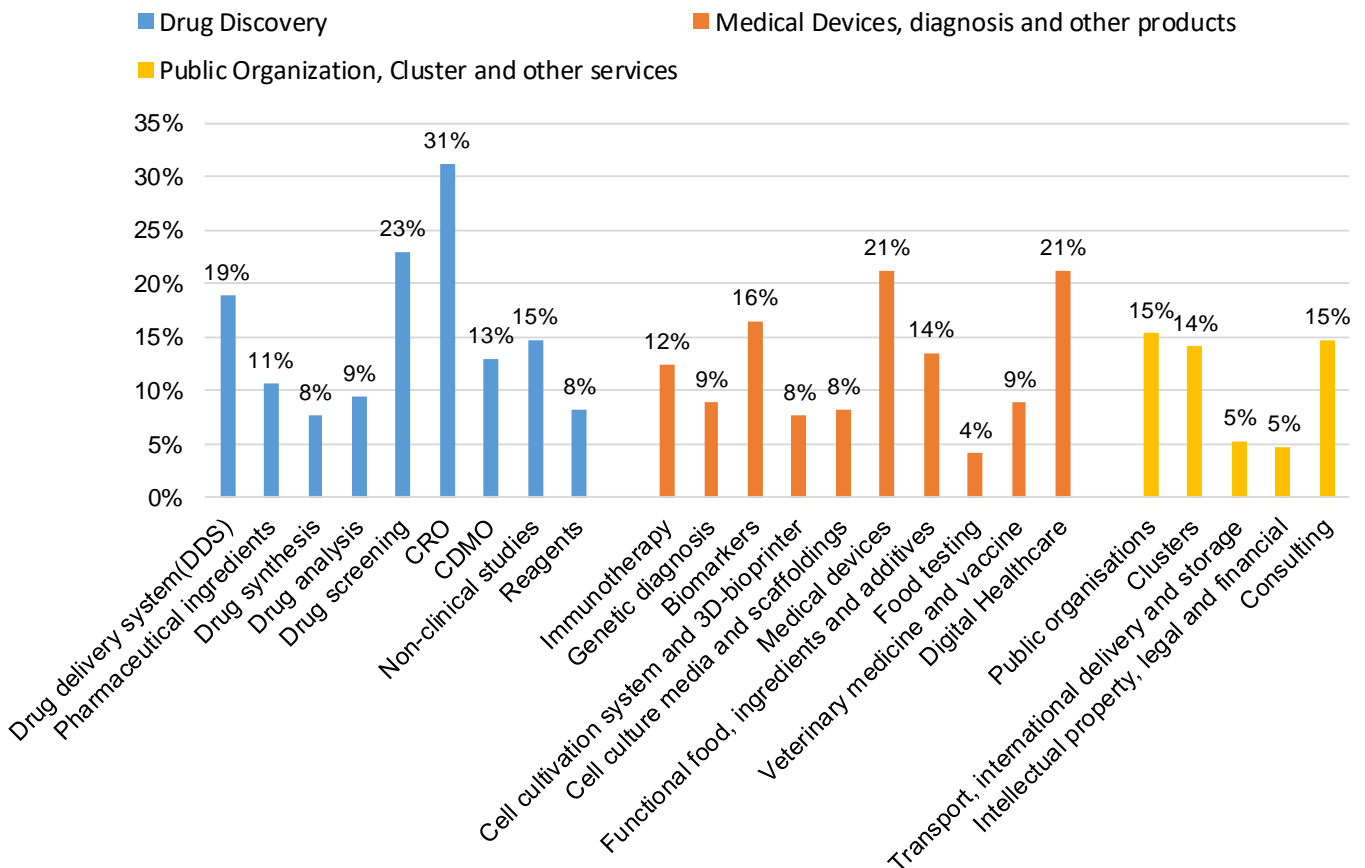

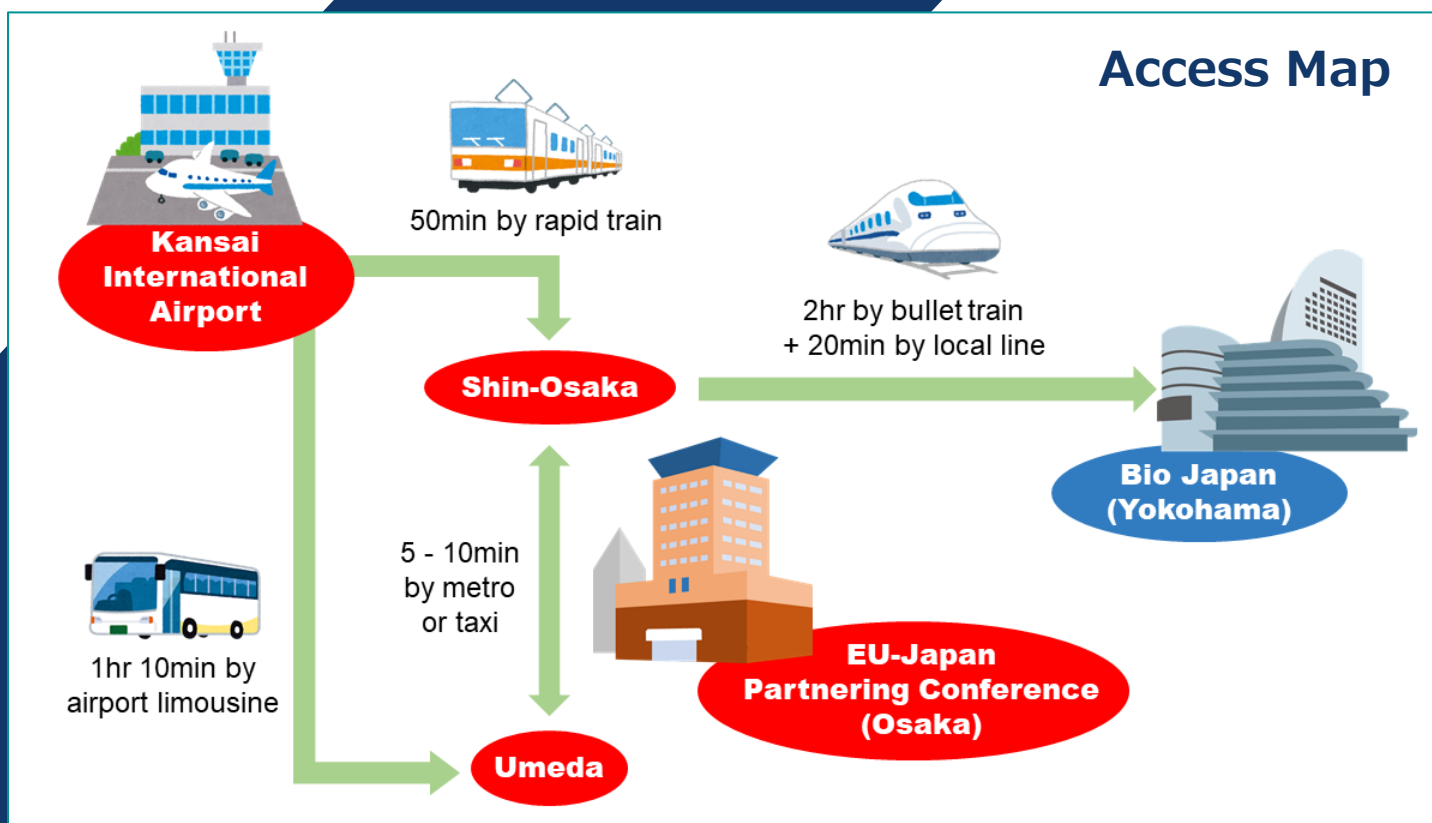
